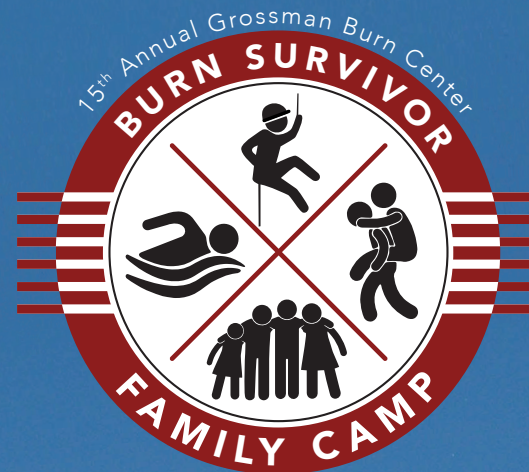

Where do we sleep?

There are women's cabins and men's cabins, with bunk beds and bathrooms and showers in each.
